








An Arizona Native American Art Experience



THE HISTORY OF HOPI ART Artwork has been an important part of Hopi life and culture for thousands of years, making Hopi artists some of the most accomplished in the world. Almost all of the artists have been taught by their elders, who continue to pass their knowledge down from generation to generation.

TYPES OF ART -



BASKETRY & WEAVING
Hopi baskets are derived from
techniques that can be traced
back thousands of years.
Hopi artists produce a unique
style of plaques, bowls, and trays,
which are either for sale or for
ceremonial use.



Hopi pottery is made with the "coil and scrape" technique, from clay that is hand dug on Hopi land. The pots and clay art are painted in natural pigments

POTTERY & CLAY

are painted in natural pigments with a yucca leaf brush and then fired in open pits with natural fuel.



CARVING & KATSINAS

Katsina dolls are three-dimensional representations of the Katsinas that visit the villages for ceremonial dances and observances. They are hand carved from cottonwood root and painted to represent figures from Hopi beliefs.



JEWELRY & SILVERWORK

Distinctive Hopi silverwork is known as silver overlay. Hopi artisans cut a design from a flat piece of silver and then fuse that to another oxidized piece which is hand scored to produce an intricate design before polishing.



OTHER ART

Hopi artists find expression in painting, sculpture, glass making, photography, and other contemporary art forms. As with other artists, their art is ever changing and evolving but always recognizably






